





#### DANGER

### DIRECTIONS

Remove loose snow and ice from vehicle windows. Spray directly onto snow, frost or ice. Spray windshield first and allow product to penetrate while spraying other windows. Start wiper blades only after ice and snow have melted. Defog the inside of windows by wiping clean with a clean cloth dampened with this deicer.
